came to Angel's Acres with her momma, in the spring of 2023. Although her mother sadly passed away shortly after her arrival, Felicia has thrived with the great care and attention she receives at our sanctuary. However, Felicia has an incurable disease that causes her joints to lock and she will eventually be unable to use her legs.



With the help of our generous donors, we were able to outfit her with a wheelchair to help improve her mobility. With her disease progressing, we will need to upgrade her to a front wheel cart, that will allow her to have full support under the front half of her body, while still being able to sit down and to chew grass as goats like to do.

Felicia is a favorite with our visitors, and you can usually find her sunbathing on the porch or spending time with her buddy, Bear the dog. She has a very sweet personality and loves getting pets and treats. Because of her condition, Felicia requires extra special care and lives indoors with Bobbie and Terry, the owners of Angel's Acres, along with Norman the goat, Bear the dog, and Boo the cat.



Many of our rescued animals have significant life long medical needs. At Angel's Acres, they can live out the rest of their lives in comfort, receving top notch care.



At the end of August, we held our 3rd annual benefit festival to raise money for the sanctuary.
